Of course, it is understood that some events can happen outside one's control, and LMs have been impressively understanding and helpful here.

There is a bit of unevenness in the distribution of duties, but I think this can't be avoided. Some people are available for more Sundays than are others, and there are fewer LMs prepared to take duties at 7.30 than at 9.30, so the "7.30 LMs" have generally ended up with more commitments. It would be appreciated if a few more LMs could make themselves available for both types of service. At different stages I've had a preference for one rather than the other, and over a long time it's actually alternated (like the earth's magnetic field). Now I enjoy both services equally, and appreciate their different strengths.

Luvuyo's name does not appear on this roster, because COTT still has to decide when its students will be involved at the Cathedral. Siya's name appears just once, in view of likely absences from town at certain periods (not yet known) between February and April. Once there is greater clarity, both Luvuyo and Siya may be able to participate in more services, and would be welcome to offer "relief" to those with quite a number of duties.
